

The Family Court Room

Family court rooms are usually laid out in a particular way as shown in the diagram below. The Cases are heard either by a Judge or Magistrates and they are always assisted by a Clerk. The Solicitors or Barristers for each person sits in front of them and will sometimes turn around to speak to their client to confirm the things that are being said. Other professionals that are called to court will come in and sit in the 'box' and leave once they have finished answering questions.
